Thank you for volunteering to help at the 2013 Sea Otter Classic. Following are directions to Laguna Seca and information and recommendations for this year's event.

Entering the Sea Otter Venue – Thursday, 4/18 – Sunday, 4/21

Take General Jim Moore Blvd. off of Canyon Del Rey in Monterey. Take your first right onto South Boundary Road. This will take you directly in to Mazda Raceway at Laguna Seca. The parking is free, so park wherever you can. Once you have parked, head towards the SCRAMP Parking Lot (located in Parking lot above athlete registration) and look for the volunteer check-in tent.

Entering the Sea Otter Venue – Sunday, 4/14 – Wednesday, 4/17

Please use the Mazda Raceway at Laguna Seca entrance off of Hwy 68

Checking-In:

Once you have located volunteer check-in, you will need to do the following:

1. Sign in on the sign-in sheet, stating your name and what organization you are with and what your job position is that you have been assigned to work at the event.
2. Sign and hand in a 2013 Sea Otter Classic waiver, (if you haven't already).
3. Get your t-shirt that you will wear when you are volunteering
4. Get your wristband that will gain you entrance to the Sea Otter Village.
5. Get your lunch to take with you.

The coordinator for the event you are working will collect you at the Volunteer Check-in booth at the designated start time on your contract. They will walk you to the event and give you all the information you will need for your position.

Additional Pointers:

1. If you are going to be volunteering all day, we recommend you bring extra water, sunscreen, a hat, extra food, and a couple of layers. The weather can change and it's always better to be prepared.
2. When working in the Back Country, you will be notified, or a vehicle will come to pick you up and bring you back to the raceway when the event is over.

In closing, we want to express a huge thank you for helping out. We CANNOT do the Sea Otter Classic without all of you. You are essential to the continuing vitality of the event; we sincerely appreciate all your efforts.
